- 1) Open Time for Public Comment No public comments were heard.
- 2) Approval of the November 6, 2013 JPA Local Task Force Minutes M/s, Kies, Irwin to approve the minutes from the November 6, 2013 meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3) <u>Proposed Changes to Model Construction and Demolition Debris Ordinance</u>
