



# CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING 2020-2021

## Tree preparation for both curbside collection and drop-off:

- Remove all tree stands (metal, plastic, wood), ornaments, lights, tinsel, etc.
- Flocked trees will not be accepted.
- Apartment building tenants should contact their manager and request that they set up one day for holiday tree collection at the property.

## CURBSIDE COLLECTION

### Bay Cities Refuse

*Sausalito, Marin City*

- Set tree on curb or cut up to fit in the green cart on your regular pickup day. Trees over 7ft must be cut in half. No date restrictions.

### Marin Sanitary Service

*Larkspur, Greenbrae, Kentfield, Las Gallinas Valley, Ross, San Anselmo, San Rafael, Fairfax and Ross Valley (Sleepy Hollow and Oak Manor)*

- Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021  
Put tree on curb on your regular yard waste pick-up day. Trees over 6ft must be cut in half.
- After Fri, Jan 15, 2021  
Trees collected curbside will result in a charge on your bill of \$5 per tree.
- Trees can be cut up and placed in the green cart on any regular collection day. Lid must close.

### Mill Valley Refuse

*Almonte, Alto, Belvedere, Corte Madera, Mill Valley, Homestead, Strawberry and Tiburon*

- Starting the week of Jan 4, 2021  
Put tree on curb on your regular green waste pick-up day. Trees over 5ft must be cut in half.

### Recology Sonoma Marin Customers in Novato

- Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 8, 2021  
Place at the curb for collection on your regular collection day. Trees over 6ft must be cut in half.
- Trees can be cut up and placed in the yard waste cart on any regular collection day. Lid must close.

### Recology Sonoma Marin Customers (except Novato)

*Bolinas, Forrest Knolls, Inverness, Marshall, Muir Beach, Nicasio, Olema, Point Reyes Station, San Geronimo, Stinson Beach, West Marin and Woodacre*

- Cut up tree and place in the yard waste cart on any regular collection day. Lid must close.

### Tamalpais CSD

- Tue, Jan 12 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021  
Put tree on curb on your regular collection day.
- \$30 charge for collection before Jan 12th or after Jan 15th
- Trees can be cut into pieces up to 2 ft long and 4 inches in diameter and placed in the green cart. Lid must close.

## DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

**NOTE:** Trees taller than 6 ft must be cut in half.

**Kentfield:** Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021

- College of Marin, Parking Lot #12 (south of gym)

**Larkspur:** Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021

- Piper Park, 250 Doherty Dr.
- Drakes L and Niven Park, 13 Barry Way (across the street from Fire Station #16)

**Marinwood:** Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021

- Marinwood Community Center, 77 Miller Creek Rd. (next to Fire Station #58)

**Point Reyes:** Sat, Dec 26, 2020 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021, 8:00am-5:00pm.

- Point Reyes Fire Station, 4th & B Streets

**Ross:** Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021

- Marin Art & Garden Center, 30 Sir Francis Drake Blvd. (across from fire station)  
Please DO NOT drop trees at the Fire Station.

**San Rafael:** Mon, Jan 4 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021

- Pickleweed Park & Albert J Boro Community Center, 50 Canal St.
- Fire Station #55, 955 Point San Pedro Rd. (Glenwood/Peacock Gap Area)
- Scotty's Market Parking Lot, Manuel T. Freitas Parkway & Del Ganado

*Until Jan 31, 2021:*

- Marin Resource Recovery Center, 565 Jacoby St.  
Residents may drop off up to 2 trees. There will be a charge for flocked trees.

**Sausalito:** Tue, Dec 29 – Mon, Jan 18, 2021

- Debris box at MLK parking lot off of Coloma St.

**Stinson/Bolinas:** Mon – Sat, 8:00am – 5:00pm.

- Bolinas-Stinson Resource Recovery Park, 25 Olema Bolinas Rd.

**Tomales:** Sat, Dec 26, 2020 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021, 8:00am – 5:00pm.

- Tomales Fire station, 599 Dillon Beach Rd.

**Woodacre:** Sat, Dec 26, 2020 – Fri, Jan 15, 2021, 8:00am – 5:00pm.

- Woodacre Fire Station, 33 Castle Rock Rd.
