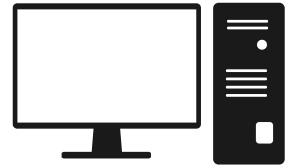
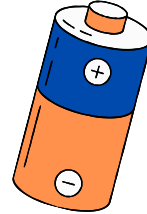
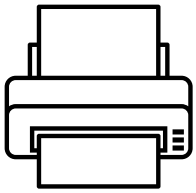


Handling Hazardous Waste at Schools

Why have a hazardous waste collection system? In California, it is illegal to dispose of hazardous waste in regular landfill, recycling and compost containers, through abandonment, or down the drain.



Common Examples of Hazardous Waste at Schools:

- Batteries
- Fluorescent + LED bulbs
- Paint + paint thinner
- E-waste (computers, printers)
- Printer ink + toner cartridges
- Fertilizers + pesticides
- Cleaning chemicals + pool chemicals
- Chemistry class chemicals
- Some construction materials

Drop-Off Options

Instructions for drop off at the Marin Household Hazardous Waste Facility:

- Review the list of accepted materials
- Complete an inventory of your items
- Register with a temporary or permanent State Generator ID #
- Schedule an appointment for drop-off
