3. Legislative Update & Update on National Organic Board Meeting

Staff Meilin Tsao updated LTF that the National Organics Standards Board had their semi-annual meeting and addressed the Biodegradable Products Institutes (BPI) petition. The petition was to have all biodegradable products tested as one entity, the response the petition was to stick with standing practices of testing products individually.

A discussion regarding organics labeling, compostable, and draft regulations.

4. Update on FY 24/25 Pilot Programs

Staff Casey Fritz shared the goals for each of the four pilot programs and partners. Reuse & Repair Fairs (partner: Reuse Alliance) are aimed to have 10-12 community events over the next year to help items that are brought in by community members to work individually with volunteer fixers for repairs. The LFT are working the Reuse Alliance and connecting them with city/town managers and community groups.

Reusable in Schools and Farmers' Markets (partner: Sparkl Reusables) will be involved in the Marinwood Market lunch program to convert the disposable to reusables. The LTF will assist in the program visibility for the farmers' market.

The BYOCup Campaign will create the display decals for businesses. The LTF will assist in discussions with local businesses to display decals.

The food dehydrators (partner: Mill Industries) will provide up to 125 free food dehydrators for qualifying residents and non-profit groups. The LFT will aid in reaching out to qualifying friends and community groups regarding the program.

A brief question and answer session was held.

5. Solicit Feedback on BYOCup Pilot Program Designs

Staff Fritz shared the potential decal designs with the LTF and facilitated the discussion for feedback. Staff Fritz will take the feedback for new iterations of decal designs.

6. Report Out from Subcommittees

Construction and Demolition subcommittee reported from the October training for panel reuse for ZWM and California Product Stewardship Program (CPSC) for solar panel module reuse. Marin County has the highest penetration of solar panels per capita in the county, this targeted reusing modules from home installations. Additionally, there will be a continued focus on the deconstruction ordinances to draft a recommendation to present to the JPA board.

Chuck Hornbrook left to catch a ferry.

Infrastructure and End Markets subcommittee reported no update.

Compliance and Regulations subcommittee reported no update.

Outreach and Education subcommittee reported taking up issues with multifamily unit buildings being compliant with the law regarding recycling and composting with adequate bins. Additionally, quested information for the backend process of ZWM websites complaint portal. Staff Fritz shared the process on non-compliant complaints and consequences.
