#### 3. Legislative Update

Staff Meilin Tsao informed the LTF parts of SB54 are enacted and there is a de facto ban on polystyrene food service ware ("Styrofoam") which needed a 25% recycling rate (2%-4% currently). A full report from the state's largest polystyrene producer on their recycling rate and are subject to the enforcement penalties per SB54 and is being enforced by CalRecycle. The report is being awaited by CalRecycle for enforcement measures on food service ware. Bi-metal cans are now deemed recyclable by CalRecycle and jurisdictions/haulers will now need to manage collection.

#### 4. Update on ZWM Outreach Programs

Staff Casey Fritz shared the update for the reusable products from the Thursday Farmer's Market (Civic Center) are from Sparkl Reuseables, providing the logistical support and materials. Vendors optionally opt-in, food is served on reusables, after food/drinks use the items are brought back to Sparkl for cleaning and return to vendors. Data is being collected for potential upscaling in the future based on merit from programming.

Staff Fritz shared the samples of the BYOC with the LTF and held open discussion for feedback on design and application.
